

Canned Mushrooms



1st choice Miniature M2

RAW MATERIAL

Fresh mushrooms (*Agaricus bisporus*), with closed or slightly open caps.

PRESENTATION

Canned 1st choice mushrooms in brine, with cap diameters max 20 mm, whose length of stem is equal to a maximum of 2/3 cap diameter.

The size grading is made by a mechanical system with cylinder holes. The system will perform a grading size according to the smallest diameter of the hat.

SPECIFICATIONS

Criteria		% max (% drained weight)
1	Poorly trimmed Mushrooms are poorly trimmed when they have a trace of culture substrate of at least 2mm diameter, which may be attached or not to the mushroom.	5 %
2	Blemished Mushrooms are blemished when they have a dark brown blemish with a diameter >3mm or when they are very spotted (> 10 black spots)	5 %
3	Open caps Mushrooms have open caps when the gills appear on at least the half of the cap and if there is more than 4mm between the cap and the stem.	8 %
4	Broken and pieces Mushrooms are broken when at least the ¼ of the cap is missing, caps only, stems only.	10 %
5	Overgrade > 20mm The size grading is made by a mechanical system with cylinder holes. The system will perform a grading according to the size of the smallest diameter of the hat.	5 %
